Responsibilities

- Garner participation and collaboration with colleagues, generating enthusiasm for the program
- Assist in coordinating and staffing local PAL volunteer efforts and philanthropic initiatives; mobilizing team members to participate
- Provide PAL with feedback on program execution and input on strategy, activities and implementation

Time Commitment

- **Member commitment on a one year timeframe**
- **Meetings every other month:** Receive updates from team and plan for upcoming volunteer events and community initiatives.
- **On-going responsibilities (Up to two hours per week).** Activities may include:
 - Garner participation and engagement from team members in your area
 - Discuss local funding requests with PAL Junior Board Leader
 - Participate as a leader of local program events, promoting and staffing events
 - Research and identify local opportunities for PAL, charity events, volunteer engagements and grant opportunities; maintain relationships with existing partners
